




#### **OUR THEME: KARBALA INSPIRES**

## THE STORY OF JA'FAR IBN AQIL



#### INTRODUCTION

In the battle of Karbala, countless brave souls sacrificed their lives alongside Imam Husayn (as). Let's **uncover the stories** of the lesser-known martyrs who fought valiantly for justice and righteousness.



#### JA'FAR IBN AQIL

Meet Ja'far ibn Aqil, a remarkable warrior and companion of Imam Husayn (as). Son of Aqil ibn Abu Talib and Umm Thaqr bint Amir, Ja'far was a true symbol of valour and determination.



#### AN ILLUSTRIOUS LINEAGE

Descended from the noble **lineage of Abu Talib**, Ja'far ibn Aqil carried the bloodline of Hashim and Ghalib. His lineage added strength to his resolve on the battlefield.



#### THE BATTLE BEGINS

When the battle commenced, Ja'far ibn Aqil fearlessly charged into the fray, following the footsteps of Abd Allah ibn Muslim. He engaged in combat with unwavering bravery.



# THE STORY OF BURAYR IBN KHUDAYR AL-HAMDANI



#### A NOBLE DESCENT

Hailing from the esteemed **Bani Mashriq lineage**, he was born into the Banu Hamdan, originally from Yemen. His noble heritage instilled in him a strong sense of devotion and righteousness.



#### **SCHOLAR & COMPANION**

He was not only a brave warrior but also a distinguished Qari' of the Quran. He dedicated his life to teaching the sacred text in Masjid al-Kufa. He was counted among the Tabi'un and had the honor of being a companion of Imam Ali (as).



#### A CALL FOR JUSTICE

Upon learning of Imam Husayn's migration from Medina to Karbala, Burayr felt compelled to join Husayn's army. He left his home in Kufa to stand beside the Imam, ready to fight for truth and righteousness.



#### THE DENIAL OF WATER

In the Battle of Karbala, Umar ibn Sa'd's denial of water to deeply troubled Burayr and other companions. **Burayr fearlessly confronted him**, reminding him of his duty to the family of prophethood and challenging his claim of knowing God and His Messenger.



#### THE MUBAHALA CHALLENGE

Yazid bin Moqal, an ally of Abd al-Qays, taunted Burayr in a show of arrogance. Burayr responded by challenging him to a Mubahala (imprecation contest), calling upon God's curse on whoever was a liar. They stood before the two camps, and Burayr emerged victorious.



#### THE FALL OF AN ENEMY

During the contest, Burayr struck a mighty blow that split Yazid's (an enemy soldier) helmet and reached his brain. Yazid fell lifeless, his arrogance silenced by Burayr's unwavering faith and valour



#### **UNYIELDING COURAGE**

Undeterred by his victory, Burayr unleashed his wrath upon Ibn Sa'd's camp. **He condemned them** as 'murderers of the son of the daughter of the Messenger of God.' Burayr's bravery knew no bounds as he fought for justice



#### **BETRAYAL & MARTYRDOM**

In the midst of the battle, Burayr faced Razi ibn Munqidh Abadi in combat. Despite subduing him, Burayr was blindsided by Ka'b ibn Jabir Azadi, who struck him with a fatal blow from a spear. Burayr embraced martyrdom, leaving a legacy of unwavering loyalty.

# THE STORY OF BASHIR IBN AMR AL-KINDI



#### A NOBLE HERITAGE

Bashir ibn Amr al-Hadhrami hailed from the illustrious

Kinda tribe of Hadhramaut. His lineage instilled in him a strong sense of honour and loyalty.



#### **ANSWERING THE CALL**

When the call of Imam Husayn (as) reached Bashir's ears, he immediately joined the Imam's camp. Alongside his sons, he pledged his **unwavering allegiance** to the cause of justice.



#### **SACRIFICE FOR FAMILY**

Upon learning of Imam Husayn's migration from Medina to Karbala, Burayr felt compelled to join Husayn's army. He left his home in Kufa to stand beside the Imam, ready to fight for truth and righteousness.



#### **HUSAYN'S COMPASSION**

Upon learning of Bashir's sacrifice, Imam Husayn (a) expressed his admiration and granted him freedom from allegiance. However, Bashir's devotion to the Imam remained steadfast.



#### DETERMINATION TO STAY

Bashir **vowed never to abandon Imam Husayn (a)** and his cause, declaring that he would not leave the Imam alone with so few supporters, even if it meant searching for his captive son in caravans. His loyalty knew no bounds



#### A COSTLY REQUEST

Witnessing Bashir's unwavering dedication, Husayn entrusted him with a task. He requested Bashir to sell his precious clothes, worth 1000 dinars, to help free his captive son, Muhammad.



#### **MARTYRDOM**

According to one source, when Imam Husayn (a) prepared to face the battlefield, only Bashir and Amr ibn Abi Muta remained alive among his companions. When Bashir found that the Imam was preparing to go to the battlefield, he went to fight before he did.



#### REMEMBRANCE IN ZIARAT

Bashir ibn Amr al-Hadhrami's name is revered in the **Ziarat al-Rajabiyya**, a testament to his valiant sacrifice. He is honored among those who laid down their lives for the cause of Imam Husayn.

# THE STORY OF ABD ALLAH IBN YAQTAR



#### **BROTHERHOOD**

Abd Allah ibn Yaqtar, hailing from Banu Layth, was born in Medina. He shared a special bond with Husayn ibn Ali, having been breastfed by the same woman. This relationship earned him the title of the Rida'i brother of Husayn



#### AMBASSADOR TO KUFA

According to **some references**, Imam Husayn entrusted Abd Allah ibn Yaqtar with a **crucial mission**. He was sent as an ambassador to Kufa, carrying a letter to Muslim ibn Aqil, informing him of Husayn's journey and the impending events



#### **DEFIANCE & MARTYRDOM**

Abd Allah's unwavering loyalty to Husayn led him to a tragic fate. **Refusing to curse Ali and Husayn**, he was thrown off the roof of the palace by the order of Ibn Ziyad. Though his fall did not kill him, he suffered broken bones and excruciating pain



#### FINAL ACT OF COMPASSION

In his agony, Abd Allah was beheaded by a man named Abd al-Malik ibn Umayr al-Lakhmi. When objections were raised, the man claimed to have relieved Abd Allah of his pain. His martyrdom was marked by an act of twisted mercy



#### **LEGACY OF COURAGE**

Abd Allah ibn Yaqtar's selflessness and **bravery** serve as a powerful inspiration for us today. Through his story, we are reminded of the timeless values of righteousness and standing up for what is just.

# THE STORY OF ABU THUMAMA AL-SA'IDI



#### A LOYAL COMPANION

Abu Thumama al-Sa'idi, also known as Amr ibn Abdullah ibn Ka'b, was a nobleman from Kufa & a prominent companion of both Imam Ali (a) and Imam Hussayn (a).



#### **SUPPORT FOR IMAM HUSAYN**

After the passing of Mu'awiya, Abu Thumama was among those who gathered to invite Imam Husayn to Kufa, urging him to lead the uprising against oppression. He sent a letter to Imam Husayn while he was in Mecca




#### PILLAR OF THE UPRISING

Abu Thumama was not only a fervent supporter of Imam Husayn but also played a crucial role in managing financial affairs, purchasing weapons, and organizing the charitable efforts of the people of Kufa during the time of Muslim ibn Aqil



#### **COMMANDER OF TRIBES**

In the uprising against Ubayd Allah ibn Ziyad, Abu Thumama was appointed by Muslim ibn Aqil as the commander of the Tamim and Hamdan tribes. His leadership and strategic skills rallied the support of these tribes



### RECOMMENDED ACTS ON THE DAY OF ASHURA



**Avoid** attending to your business, employment matters, laughing and unnecessary discussions.



Refrain from eating & drinking **until afternoon** (This is not a fast).



The **A'maal** of Ashura, along with recommended supplications and Ziyarats.



Reflect on the sacrifice of Imam Husayn & try to think of ways you can learn and develop from it.



Recite **surah Ikhlas** as many times as possible



Salwat as many times as possible



When seeing other believers, it is recommended to console each other by saying the following:

Adhama Allahu ujurana wa ujurakum bi musabinah bil Husayn, alayhi as-salam.

Or the full version including Wa ja'alana min al-talibeen bi tha'rihi ma' waliyihi al-Imam al-Mahdi, ajala Allahu farajahu al-shareef min aali Muhammad, sallallahu alayhi wa aalahi wa sallam.

Translation: May Allah make our reward and your reward great for our grief for Husayn peace be upon him. May He place us and you from those who help His cause with His representative, the guided Imam from the family of Muhammad, peace and blessings be upon him and his family.
